LDHS@HOME will replace current teacher webpages and will be updated by 6:00 on every Sunday night for the following week. LDHS@Home is organized by content area > specific courses. Students and Parents will need to access each teacher's LDHS@HOME site to collect the learning activities for the week. Each teacher will be posting two or three learning activities each week. Each activity is designed to take about 15 minutes to complete, and there will be options that may or may not require technology. For your convenience, there is a tutorial video on the LDHS@HOME home page to learn how to navigate LDHS@HOME. There is also a Tech Support button you may click if you need additional support navigating the site.

Our goal is to make LDHS@HOME an opportunity for your student to continue to engage in content, practice important skills that are vertically aligned across grade levels, have success in completing the activities, and provide opportunities to enrich and extend student learning.
