Starting Monday morning, learning at LDMS is going to take on a new look. LDMS@Home will be the new online learning platform accessible through the district (ldisd.net) and campus websites.

LDMS@Home will replace current teacher webpages and will be updated by 6:00 p.m. on Sunday night for the following week. LDMS@Home is organized by department > grade level > teacher. Students and Parents will need to access each teacher's LDMS@Home site to collect the learning activities for the week. Each content area will be posting three learning activities each week. Each learning activity is designed to take about 20 minutes to complete, and there will be options that may or may not require technology. For your convenience, there is a tutorial video on the LDMS@Home homepage to learn how to navigate LDMS@Home.

To create consistency across the campus, all activities will be posted as Google Slides (like Powerpoints for those that are more familiar with Microsoft) and have similar organization. On each Slide Deck, there is a learning activity that students will need to complete, and students will then submit their learning evidence on a Google Form that can be found on every page of the LDMS@Home site. Each teacher has provided a page of additional resources for those students that would like the opportunity to access activities that will provide refinement or enrichment of skills.

Our goal is to make LDMS@Home an opportunity for your student to continue to practice important skills that are vertically aligned across grade levels, have success in completing the activities, and provide opportunities for families to have some fun in the process.
