- ❖ Meeting: LDISD Central Services Meeting Room E, 11.6.2019. Matt Clark called the meeting to order at 3:01 p.m.

- ❖ Agenda
 - The agenda was approved by the committee.
 - The minutes from our 1.8.2020 meeting were read by Mr. Clark and approved by the committee.
- ❖ Coach Aaron Walterscheid gave the committee a report on the services with whom the health classes work to provide services. He outlined the program provided by Living Choices of North Texas, which educates students about healthy relationship, STIs, STDs and laws relating to dating. He also told us about Refuge for Women, who provides information about sex trafficking. Coach Walterscheid also mentioned Denton County Friends of the Family and the services they provide.
- ❖ The committee discussed the Stop the Bleed training provided to staff at Lake Dallas Middle School, Lake Dallas Elementary, Shady Shores Elementary on January 6th by member of the Lake Cities Fire Department. The training will be presented at Corinth Elementary on February 17th. The committee discussed student training through the health classes at the high school. That training is scheduled for the spring and will be provided by Mr. Moore and Ms. Ramirez. They are looking into the possibility of certifying Coach Walterscheid to train students in his health classes.
- ❖ Mr. Clark provided a report on the Signs of Suicide program at the high school and middle school. We will use the program with sixth graders next week. The program was completed at all other secondary grades in the fall.
- ❖ The committee continued its discussion on vaping from the previous meeting. It was recommended that the district include the policy currently used at the secondary campuses in the Student Handbook at that it be part of materials distributed by extra-curricular coaches and sponsors.
