- Introductions - The committee introduced themselves.
- Matt Clark announced that he is stepping down from SHAC

- Ms. McKinley reviewed the SHAC Bylaws and Responsibilities

- Ms. McClendon reported on Trauma informed care, which is the situational awareness of how some students come to school having experienced trauma and explained ways in which to respond to students in crisis.

- Mr. Dominguez reviewed the District Threat Assessment Teams process and how it uses student data to drive the level of intervention given to the student.

- Mr. Dominguez also spoke about ongoing ways in which the district is increasing awareness of educator wellness.

- Mr. Dominguez stated that he would explore parent involvement with educator

wellness including (e.g. supplies, etc.) and there was a discussion that the PTAs typically help but that participation has been low.

- Ms. McKinley asked why the MS was the only campus without microwaves for student use in the cafeteria. Mr. Dominguez explained that the new logistics of the cafeteria to facilitate social distancing prevented them from being utilized at the beginning of the year. However, after feedback from students, staff began working on a way to place the microwaves in socially distanced locations and should be set up by Friday, 9/25/2020.
