- ❖ Agenda
 - Agenda was approved by the committee.
 - The minutes from our 11.09.16 meeting were read and approved.
- ❖ Katie Chalkley, LDHS Student Council Sponsor and Noah Payne, chairman of the LDHS DASH committee presented information on DASH activities. Although the activities were numerous the central theme was safe driving. They cited that car crashes are the number one killer of teens in the US. They also mentioned the Shattered Dreams program at the high school, which is a community wide effort to show the possible disastrous outcomes of drinking and driving. They also mentioned “Dude Be Nice”, which is new at the high school this year. It’s design is to celebrate acts of kindness and develop a “pay it forward” culture.
- ❖ Mr. Clark presented information about the Parenting and Parental Awareness (P.A.P.A.) program mandated to be part of all health classes in the state of Texas.
- ❖ The committee also talked about “Living Choices of North Texas”, a program currently used in the health classes at Lake Dallas High School to help students make good decisions regarding dating and sexually related activities. The committee expressed an interest in learning more about their presentation.
- ❖ Ms. Lunsford mentioned the absence of a program to educate students about body-awareness at the elementary level. Mr. Clark agreed to talk to district personnel about what is being taught regarding sex education and body-awareness throughout the district. This is last scheduled SHAC meeting of the school year but the committee agreed to meet again this year if such a meeting could be used to craft a recommendation for a consistent curriculum.
